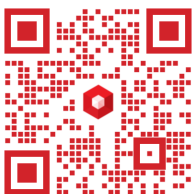

Neck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thyroid anatomy and pathology (nodular and diffuse disease) Carotid artery (stenosis, dissection) Lymph nodes (normal vs abnormal)
Liver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Diffuse liver disease (fatty liver, hepatitis, cirrhosis) Focal liver lesions (cysts, abscesses, hemangiomas, metastases)
Biliary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gallbladder pathology (stones, sludge, inflammation, polyps) Biliary ducts (dilatation, stones)
Spleen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Normal spleen anatomy and variants Splenomegaly Splenic trauma and focal lesions (cysts, abscess)
Pancreas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Normal pancreatic anatomy and variants Pancreatitis (acute and chronic) Pancreatic masses (cystic and solid lesions)
Renal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kidney anatomy and pathology (hydronephrosis, stones, infections, cysts, masses) Bladder pathology (obstruction, diverticula, stones)
Female Pelvis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uterine anatomy and pathology (fibroids, adenomyosis, endometrial polyps) Ovarian and adnexal anatomy and pathology (cystic and solid masses, ovarian torsion, polycystic ovaries)
Procedural Guidance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gain practical experience in ultrasound-guided thyroid FNA and abscess drainage
