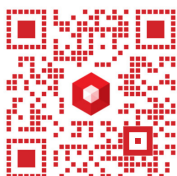
COURSE OVERVIEW

Pathology includes foreign body detection, cellulitis, abscess, haematoma and fracture detection.	
USNP105	Early Pregnancy Ultrasound	Ultrasound Early Pregnancy	This module provides an introduction to ultrasound techniques and appearances for early pregnancy scans in a critical care setting focusing on foetal heartbeat detection.
